System Requirements

Production

- Windows 98, ME, NT, 2000, XP or Vista.
- 113 MB available disk space, 800 x 600 screen resolution, 16-bit color

Hosting

- Any HTTP web server, no special server-side software

Playback

- Any operating system with standard Java support such as Windows, Linux, Solaris, Mac OS, OS/2 and Symbian EPOC, and
 - Any Java enabled browser, such as Internet Explorer 4+, Netscape Navigator 4+, Safari, Mozilla, and Opera 4+;

- Any of the most commonly used e-mail programs such as Outlook 2000+, Outlook Express 5+, Netscape Messenger, Mozilla Mail, AOL Webmail, Lotus Notes R5 and Eudora 4.3+;
 - BlackBerry handheld with BlackBerry device software 3.8 or later;
 - Palm smartphone with Palm OS version 5.0 or later and Bluetooth (Impatica software verified with 680P, 700P and 755P);
 - Sony Ericsson handheld with Java platform 5 or higher and Bluetooth;
 - Windows Mobile Smartphone or Pocket PC with Windows Mobile 2003 or later and Bluetooth.

New Features

- Support for Palm OS mobile handheld devices: Convert presentations to load, view and project from Palm OS handhelds;
- BlackBerry output from Mobile Edition view: Create BlackBerry-compatible files in the same view used for other mobile handhelds.

Resolved Issues

Impatica for PowerPoint 4.0.2 includes more than 90 improvements and bug fixes over version 4.0.0, especially in the following areas:

- Loading presentations over-the-air or using desktop manager to BlackBerry handhelds with device software 4.2.2 or higher;
- Loading presentations via USB to password-protected BlackBerry handhelds with device software 4.2.2 or higher;
- Audio playback;
- Playback issues arising from resizing of browser or presentation window;
- Inter-character text spacing;
- Text and shape formatting in PowerPoint 2007 files;
- Picture bullets in PowerPoint 2007 files;
- Animated GIF support;
- Animation and slide transition support for PowerPoint 2007 files;
- Conversion issues with very large PNG images;
- Generation of SCORM packages;
- Support for picture shadows and WordArt in PowerPoint 2007 files.

Known Issues

- In some cases grouped objects in PowerPoint 2007 (.pptx) files do not convert properly (e.g., some shapes may not appear, text may be misaligned on a shape, etc). Ungrouping such objects usually improves results.
- When viewing a presentation containing multiple videos in full screen mode, the second and subsequent videos may not play. To view these videos, the user must exit full screen mode.

- Hyperlinks to other slides within a PowerPoint 2007 (.pptx) presentation can be incorrect if hidden slides are used. The recommended workaround is to convert a copy of the presentation that has the hidden slides removed.
 - WordArt type text is supported for PowerPoint 2007 (.pptx) files, but is limited to single paragraphs that contain a single text run.
 - Shadows on text are not supported for PowerPoint 2007 (.pptx) files.
 - For PowerPoint 2007 (.pptx) files, animations on master slide are not supported. To maintain the animations, copy them directly onto the slide.
 - In some cases, for PowerPoint 2007 (.pptx) files, shapes with entrance animations may appear on the slide then disappear before performing the entrance animation.
 - Converting audio to WAV PCM format produces low-quality results. To obtain better results, use Compact format (for bandwidth-limited delivery) or AU μ Law format (for higher-bandwidth delivery).
