### Release Date – February 17, 2005

Version 3.3.3f of Impatica OnCue is released. This release includes fixes to a number of problems identified in version 3.3.2. This Release Note describes the changes made since the release of Impatica OnCue 3.3.2.

### Bug Fixes (Reported Incidents)

The following ticketed incidents reported in previous versions of the product have been fixed

Incident Number	Identified Problem or Symptom	Resolution
	Audio would crackle and generally sound poor in newly released Java 5.	Audio playback in Java 5 is improved.
1556	Under certain circumstances, the value specified in the custom speed field would not be used for conversion.	Fixed
1557	The Net Target Connection speed was not re-calculated and presented upon changing the custom target speed.	Fixed
1561	Some scripts would generate problems during conversion because characters ('>' and '^') were not being properly escaped.	Fixed
1564	Presentations that were opened from a link in another presentation would have their table of contents and scrolling text spaced too far apart.	Fixed
1572	Un-muting a presentation causes the volume to be set to the maximum rather than to the level it was prior to muting.	Fixed
1592	Animation timings would be off once converted for "appear" animations.	Fixed
1596	If the user added an extra slash to their web site location connection setting then made a connection, navigated to a sub folder then opened an HTML page, an extra slash would be inserted in the URL.	Fixed
1597	Presentations converted with new audio formats would lock-up during playback if the viewer used navigation features, such as paragraph advance buttons or searching.	Fixed
1653	Audio formats such a MP3, DV and AU could not be selected as an asset.	Fixed
